

You're invited to read your notes on PatientSite!



OpenNotes gives you online access to health care notes your doctors, nurses and other clinicians write after an appointment or discussion. Notes may summarize what was discussed, the findings, what was measured and the treatment plan.

Reading notes can help you remember what you and your clinician talked about and prepare

for your next visit. Patients in an OpenNotes research study reported that reading notes helped them better understand their health, take medications as prescribed and feel more in control of their care.

Beth Israel Deaconess is among the first in the country to share notes in this way.
